Social Studies

Topic: World/United States Geography

Students will use a map to identify physical features of the United States. They will discuss cartography and learn about Alexander von Humboldt. This topic addresses the following PA Academic Standard: 7.1.5.A.

Topic: United States and Regions

Students will learn about the natural regions of the United States. They will discuss physical features such as mountains, plains, and plateaus. This topic addresses the following PA Academic Standards: 7.1.5.B, 7.1.5.A, 7.2.5.A, 7.2.5.B, 7.3.5.A, 7.4.5.A, and 7.4.5.B.

Topic: American Indian Nations

Students will discuss ancient civilizations/historic tribes and compare cultural aspects by region. This topic addresses the following PA Academic Standards: 7.1.5.B, 6.1.5.A, 6.1.5.B, 6.1.5.C, 6.1.5.D, 7.1.5.A, 7.2.5.A, 7.3.5.A, 8.3.5.A, and 8.3.5.B.

Topic: How Did It All Begin?

Students will examine and understand the causes and effects of European colonization in the United States beginning in 1565. This topic addresses the following PA Academic Standards: 7.1.5.A, 7.3.5.A, 8.1.5.B, 8.1.5.C, 8.3.5.A, and 8.3.5.B.

Topic: Spanish and Portuguese Explorers

Students will discover the process of exploration by focusing on motives and accomplishments of early Spanish and Portuguese explorers. This topic addresses the following PA Academic Standards: 7.1.5.A, 7.3.5.A, 8.1.5.B, 8.1.5.C, 8.3.5.A, and 8.3.5.B.

Topic: English and French Explorers

Topic: Dividing the New World

Students will know some benefits of interaction among American Indians, explorers, and colonists and will discuss the Columbian Exchange. Topic: Early English Colonies

Topic: New England Colonies

Topic: Middle Colonies

Topic: The American Revolution

Topic: Growing Pains

Students will discuss some of the problems facing the new nation—a weak central government, Shays' rebellion and the need for a national currency. Topic: Plans for the New Government

Students will demonstrate their understanding of the Constitution and Declaration of Independence and will compare Federalist and Anti-Federalist views of government. Topic: Government of the People

Students will explain the structure and function of government. Topic: Louisiana Purchase

Topic: Westward Ho!

Topic: Industry vs. Agriculture

Topic: The Civil War

Topic: The War Continues
