10. Public Comments

Comments regarding superintendent search:

- Holly Thorne questioned the board on the cost of the search firm's services and the process. Margaret Piper responded that the district contacted firms and firms presented. The cost of the search was negotiated not to exceed \$22,000. Hazard, Young, Attea & Associates was in the middle range. Many are much more. Mrs. Piper stated the services will help draw in a pool of candidates on a wider network than the board has generated locally. She also stated that this is the most important decision we can make for the next ten years.
- Holly Thorne questioned what would happen if the firm was unable to find a candidate. Mrs. Piper responded that this has never occurred with this particular firm. She added that the Board should be able to hire a new superintendent prior to the beginning of the new fiscal year. Stephen Dewar commented that the company would continue its search without any further cost to the district beyond its six-month timeline.

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> Raymond McGinnis commented that the reason for hiring the search firm is a result of their own attempt at not being able to produce a satisfying group of candidates. The firm has a good success of satisfying school districts.

Comments on negotiations:

- Scott T. Williams stated he felt the negotiations meeting between the school board and union has gone very well and has been productive. Both sides have a clear view of the other's position. He stated that the school board is still committed to resolve this amicably and in good faith.
- Ms. Jill Roman questioned the prolonging of an agreement. She urged the school board to get the contract settled. She stated that there are enough issues going on in the district. She also stated that she felt that this is a wealthy district and she could not believe they could not come to an understanding.
- Mrs. Piper stated that she hopes the board and union can sit and talk things out. She hopes to keep the lines of communication open.
